STYLE & DESIGN

THE ALL-NEW PALFINGER FHS SERIES LOOKS NOTHING LIKE ANY OTHER TRUCK-MOUNTED FORKLIFT

The exterior has a striking look with its higher ground clearance, lower profile engine hood, powder-coated chassis, and contemporary angular styling.

Inside, there's increased legroom and a spacious operator cabin. In addition, **our patented swivel seat assembly with 25° outward rotation** increases access when entering and exiting the machine. Finally, there is an **integrated side guard** providing extra protection for the operator.

When seated, the panoramic visibility is like nothing you have seen before. The driver always has the best view of the fork tips and the entire working area.

SIDE VIEW (LEFT)

- A** Contemporary angular styling with 45° corners offers a sleek look that matches today's commercial vehicles
- B** Standard side mount operator controls eliminate the need to climb on/off the machine during the mounting/dismounting process
- C** Integrated side guard with automatic closing functionality
- D** 3-Point entry and exit with ergonomically arranged steps and grab handles for ease of entry and exit
- E** Ground level diesel fuel fill for easy refueling when the forklift is on the ground or mounted on a truck or trailer





STYLE & DESIGN



SIDE VIEW (RIGHT)

- A** Spacious ergonomic operator cabin with ergonomically arranged foot pedals, digital display and easy-reach control levers and switches with armrest
- B** Radiator panel and robust molded bumpers on rear corners
- C** Main frame side pods provide additional structural rigidity and a clean overall look



FRONT VIEW

- A** Low profile engine hood significantly increases right-hand side visibility
- B** LED work lights
- C** Front DOT compliant street lighting kit
- D** Class IV carriage opening for increased visibility



REAR VIEW

- A** Main frame design with 45° rear corners minimize turning radius and extend beyond the inset body panels, protecting them from impact
- B** ROPS and FOPS tested and approved overhead guard
- C** Strobe light
- D** Folding SMV sign
- E** Rear DOT compliant street lighting kit
- F** 180° Rear steering for maximum maneuverability
- G** 5° Inward seat positioning increases rear view visibility



MAIN FRAME CHANNELS

The sturdy main frame uses Standard 4 channel section, which enables the use of larger diameter and wider mast carriage rollers that greatly reduce loading and wear.



CARRIAGE CYLINDERS

Carriage cylinders are recessed below the mast carriage, providing a lower center of gravity for the machine and added protection from damage caused by falling debris.

CORROSION RESISTANCE AND GUARDING

- Composite body panels
- KTL-treated and powder-painted chassis
- Galvanized steps, stabilizers, wheel motor guards, transport chain hanger brackets
- Dacrotized mast chains
- Zinc-coated mast and chain rollers
- Wheel rim valve stem guards
- Protruding wrap-around chassis

SAFETY & ERGONOMICS

EASY TO OPERATE: GROUND CONTROL

The PALFINGER Ground Control System comes standard on all models and allows operators to mount and dismount the forklift from a truck or trailer without climbing on board.

Once the forklift is started, operators use three (3) ground-level electro-hydraulic switches on the side-mounting control panel to tilt, extend and lower the machine through the dismount sequence.

By eliminating operator slip and strain hazards from climbing on and off a truck-mounted forklift, PALFINGER's Ground Control System raises the standard in Operator Safety. Operators are no longer required to overextend themselves by trying to climb up on the forklift to dismount from the truck or trailer.



Lower the forklift and go...use the three switches to TILT, EXTEND and LOWER the machine to the ground



FHS 55 P REACH

The FHS 55 Reach forklift is the picture of precision, efficiency and control. Our patented Reach System extends the forks forward to the centerline of the trailer, while the mast remains firmly against the side of the truck/trailer. This allows the operator to lift full capacity loads at maximum reach while retaining the ability to tilt and side shift at all times—ensuring safe load handling. In addition, the reduced pallet and truck bed damage risk is a key advantage as the operator can lift their load free and clear of the deck.

4-WAY

Narrow roadways, paths and openings present special challenges for delivery of long loads such as lumber. This requires an agile 4-way directional forklift that can travel sideways with the load to reach the desired delivery location.



FHS 55 4W

The 4-way mode selection is as simple as the flip of a switch and within seconds you're ready to travel sideways to your final delivery point. For additional safety in standard and in 4-way mode, the FHS 55 4W is equipped with independent brakes on all 3 wheels.



FHS 55 4WP REACH

The PALFINGER FHS 55 4WP is the perfect solution for difficult, same side loading/unloading situations. The reach system allows the operator to lift full capacity loads from across the truck bed or trailer, while the steering can be switched to the front wheels to allow effortless sideways driving with the minimal space requirement.



